NOTIFICATION

No. PO(P&E-I) 19-57/2005. In pursuance of the objectives envisioned in the Punjab Health Sector Reforms Programme with principal focus on improving the Health Status of the people of the Province through better services delivery in the Devolved Health Sector, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to approve for implementation at all operational levels, the **Minimum Services Delivery (MSDS)** which also include integral components i.e., **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPS)** and **Standard Medical Protocols (SMPS)**.

2. Upon implementation, the monitoring of MSDS shall be mandated to the Director General, Health Services, Punjab and the Health Sector Reforms Programme (PMU). The Steering Committee on Health Sector Reforms Programme shall oversee and monitor progress on the overall implementation of the MSDS, whereas the issues of required training and advocacy during the implementation phase would be taken up by the Punjab Devolved Social Services Programme.
